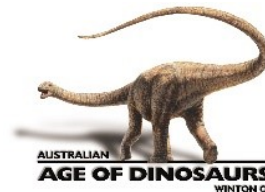

LABORATORY TOUR: See behind the scenes as never before when you tour the largest and most productive fossil preparation laboratory in the southern hemisphere. Meet the dedicated Preparators and be the first to see Australia's newest dinosaurs as they are released from their rocky tombs. There are always new fossils in the lab so every visit is a unique experience. *Timing: ~ 30 to 40 minutes.*

COLLECTION ROOM TOUR: Our most important specimens are in a new climate-controlled exhibition space. See spectacular Australian dinosaurs that are new to science, including Banjo - Australia's largest and most fearsome predatory animal. Experience our exciting digital theatre with animations of Australian dinosaurs. *Timing: ~ 30 to 40 minutes.*

DINOSAUR CANYON TOUR: Travel 2km beyond the current Reception Centre to a spectacular part of The Jump-Up where life-sized dinosaur exhibits cast in bronze sit amongst a prehistoric landscape. Dinosaur Canyon is the Museum's latest tour offering and includes an interpretation of Australian natural history, biodiversity and dinosaurs, pathways and lookouts and the Dinosaur Outpost shelter building with seating toilets and drinking water. The dinosaur exhibits include the Dinosaur Stampede representing the Lark Quarry stampede, the *Pterodactylus* Family exhibit, the *Kunbarrasaurus* exhibit, and the Death in the Billabong

exhibit, a life-sized concrete dinosaur skeleton positioned as it died in a mud hole and the beginnings of a Cretaceous Garden. Guided by experienced and passionate Museum guides, step back into a prehistoric past exclusive to the Australian Age of Dinosaurs Museum. *Timing: 60 minutes.*

TRANSFERS: It is ~500 metres between the Laboratory and the Collection Room. Your guests have the choice of being guided along the scenic walking track or transferred by your coach captain. *Timing: ~15 to 20 minutes.* Transfers from the Collection Room, at the Reception Centre to Dinosaur Canyon is by your coach captain accompanied by a Museum guide. *Transfers to Dinosaur Canyon include interpretative tour of The Jump-Up, timings ~ 30 minutes return.*
